## Required Documents for Entry:

- ✓ **Jamaican Immigration/Customs Card**

### Jamaican Immigration/Customs Card

- A Jamaican Immigration/Customs Card must be completed for each customer, including children, on each flight bound for Jamaica. The front side of the form is the Immigration Arrival/Departure record and the back side of the form is the Jamaican Customs Declaration.
- The Jamaican Arrival/Departure record is a two-part form. Complete sections A and B, then sign and date the card.
- The Arrival Record (section A) will be taken by a Customs Official upon arrival in Jamaica and the Departure Record (section B) must be retained by the customer until departure.
- The Jamaican Customs Declaration (section C) is to be completed by each customer, or head of family traveling together with children under the age of eighteen (18), on each flight bound for Jamaica.

In addition, passengers and crew members are entitled to import free of duty: 200 sticks of Cigarettes, or 50 sticks of Cigars, or 230g of Tobacco; 1 litre of Spirits; 1 litre of Wine; 170 ml of Perfumed Spirits, and 340 ml of Toilet Water.		
If you have checked 2A only, and checked NO to 3, 4, and 5 or 6, please use the GREEN LINE.		
If you have checked YES in any of the boxes above, please use the RED LINE.		
If you have checked 2B, please use the RED LINE.		
If you are in doubt, declare all your goods to the Customs Officer
