Mexican Multiple Immigration Form

- A Mexican Multiple Immigration Form must be completed for each customer, including children, on each flight bound for Mexico.
- Complete sections 1 through 14 on the left portion of the form and sections 1 through 8 on the right portion of the form.
- Once completed, sign and date both the left portion of the form.
- The back side of the form is for official use by Mexican Customs officials and should not be filled out by customers.
- The Mexican Multiple Immigration Form is separated as customers proceed through Mexican Customs and customers will retain the right portion of the form.

In case of loss carry out the replacement proceeding. • This FMM does not vouch for legal stay, it only has statistical purposes for a foreigner holding a non-ordinary passport, as well as for the holders of current immigration forms. • For a foreigner holding a Mexican visa that enables him to obtain an FM3 or FM2, this FMM vouches for his legal stay for 30 days as of entry. IT IS VERY IMPORTANT that you exchange this FMM for an FM2 or FM3 immigration form within the time period indicated at the Regional Delegation of the INM closest to your residence. Otherwise, you will be in an irregular situation and will be subject to the sanctions provided for in the General Population Law. • For foreigners who were documented as Transmigrants, Local Visitors, Provisional Visitors or in some immigration characteristic or form with a maximum stay of up to 180 days, the FMM is evidence of their legal stay in Mexico and should be handed in upon departure from the country. • To carry out lucrative activities a prior permit from immigration is required. Tourists, Transmigrants, Local Visitors and Provisional Visitors MAY NOT CARRY OUT LUCRATIVE ACTIVITIES. Transmigrants MAY NOT CHANGE THEIR IMMIGRATION STATUS OR CHARACTERISTIC. • Students or Ministers of Religion or Religious Associates documented with the FMM have the obligation to register in the National Register of Foreigners within thirty days following their admittance. • A Visitor who is a Businessperson wishing to prolong his stay in Mexico and the circumstances that motivated his entry have not changed, may request the granting of an FM3. • Upon admission to the country, the foreigner is obliged to comply strictly with the conditions established in his immigration form, with regard to the activities he will carry out and his place(s) of residence, as provided for in Articles 34 and 43 of the General Population Law. In accordance with Articles 9, 11 and 33 of the Political Constitution of the United Mexican States, he may not interfere in the country's political affairs; he may enter, leave, travel and change residence in the Republic without identity card, passport, safe-conduct or other similar requirements; this right is subordinate to the powers of the judicial authority in cases of criminal or civil responsibility, and those of the administrative authority with regard to the limitations imposed by the laws on emigration, immigration and general health of the Republic. The Executive of the Union has the exclusive power to cause to leave the national territory, immediately and without any need for prior proceedings when he deems inadvisable the presence of pernicious foreigners resident in the country. • The holder of this document enjoys, without any discrimination whatsoever, the guarantees granted by the Political Constitution of the United Mexican States; likewise, with the exception of the Transmigrant, he has the right to acquire fixed or variable income securities and make bank deposits, as well as acquire urban real estate and real rights on same, with the restrictions set forth in Article 27 of the Constitution. 	<p style="text-align: center;">INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING OUT</p> <p>UPON ARRIVAL IN MEXICO, ALL FOREIGNERS INCLUDING DIPLOMATIC PERSONNEL MUST FILL OUT THIS IMMIGRATION FORM INDIVIDUALLY AND PRESENT IT TO THE IMMIGRATION AUTHORITY AT THE POINT OF ENTRY.</p> <p>This form has two parts: make sure you fill out the arrival and departure register. Do not forget to sign the form in the appropriate box.</p> <p>Foreigners who are holders of non-ordinary passports, and the holders of current immigration forms, will fill out this immigration form for statistical purposes; in no case will this immigration form accredit their legal stay.</p> <p>Foreigners who have a Mexican visa that enables them to obtain an FM3 or FM2 must fill out this immigration form and present it at the point of entry. Within 30 days following their entry, they must initiate the proceeding to exchange this immigration form for an FM3 or FM2. AFTER SAID PERIOD THE FMM DOES NOT ACCREDIT LEGAL STAY.</p> <p>Foreigners seeking to carry out tourist activities in Mexico, transmigration or other activities that do not require a stay longer than 180 days, should fill out this immigration form and present it to the immigration authority at the entry point. During their stay in Mexico they must keep the portion of the departure register in which the entry/immigration seal appears, since it is evidence of their legal stay and will be required upon departure from the country.</p> <p>The Visitor Observer of Human Rights, Visitor for knowing Electoral Processes, Minister of Religion or Religious Associate and Correspondent require a VISA without exception. The Visitor lucrative activities up to 180 days (Professional, Adviser, Artist or Sportsperson, Position of Trust, Technicians or Scientists, Others); Visitor non-lucrative activities up to 180 days (Artist, Sportsperson, Technician, Scientist, Cooperator, Others), require a VISA or, if applicable, permit from INM; The Tourist, Transmigrant, Student, Local Visitor, Distinguished Visitor, Visiting Businessperson, will require a VISA, as provided for in international law or INM permit.</p> <p>Only foreigners on student exchange will be able to be documented as students with this FMM, or to carry out studies that do not imply official recognition of validity, with a maximum duration of 180 days.</p>
